Elections of Directors

Seven Directors are to be elected at the general meeting of members, May 20 7:00 p.m.

These seven Directors are to be elected to serve a three year term and whose duties include: service on one or more committees, service as Director on Duty or Range Certifier and aiding in the rendering of important decisions relative to the organization and management of the League. No Director shall have more than three unexcused absences from their scheduled duties or meeting in a fiscal year.

Eligibility: Any person who has been a voting member for twelve continuous months or more and being of good moral character who has no unresolved discipline actions and who shows an active interest in conservation and good sportsmanship, may be considered for nomination to the ballot for election of Directors, if that member is approved by a majority vote of the nominations committee.

The nominating committee is charged with recommending the names of members approved for election to the Board of Directors and will do so at the Board's monthly meeting, April 15.

Any member interested in volunteering to serve in helping the Club, please submit a short biography, with photo, to a nominating Committee member before April 15.

Answers to the Certification Questions

- 1) NO! THAT FIREARM IS ILLEGAL IN NEW YORK! It is a class A Misdemeanor to be in possession of an unregistered handgun. At this point, the only legal course of action is to surrender the firearm to the nearest police department or sheriff substation.
- 2) ALL firearms moved onto, or away from, the shooting bench must be in a case or in a holster that you are wearing. Any firearm that you wish to "store" while you are otherwise occupied, may be left on the rear table AS LONG AS IT IS IN A CASE. When it is time for you to use that firearm, it must be brought to the bench in a case, and uncased only at the bench. You may handle firearms ONLY at the shoot-ing bench. THIS APPLIES TO ALL FIREARMS, RIFLES AND PISTOLS!
